

NBFC & imagineNATIVE Annual Mentorship Program; Call for Applicants in New Brunswick

Application Deadline: Friday, January 10th, 2020

Calling all Indigenous filmmakers – expand your filmmaking experience by creating a 5-10 min short with the NBFC /imagineNATIVE Mentorship!

This mentorship is an opportunity to create a new short work (5-10 min), to premiere at the **annual imagineNATIVE Film + Media Arts Festival in Toronto (October 20-25, 2020)**. The mentorship recipient will work closely with NBFC staff and an Indigenous mentor to produce an original short work from concept to completion.

The selected recipient will be provided with:

- a 1 year NBFC Membership
- eligibility to enrol in any training workshops offered during NBFC's Winter and Summer 2020 Calendar
- Mentorship from NBFC staff
- Support, mentorship, and the use of equipment (production and editing) from NBFC
- \$5,100 as an artist fee
- \$4,000 for crew
- \$2,500 for production
- \$500 for on-set craft (food + beverages)

Please note: Projects must be realistic in scope within the services provided by the residency and must be completed and be delivered as a digital file to imagineNATIVE by September 9, 2020.

Eligibility Criteria:

- This call is open to Indigenous (First Nation, Métis, Inuit) candidates residing in New Brunswick
- Candidates are strongly encouraged to attend NBFC training workshops (schedule to be determined upon selection). We strongly encourage applicants who are independent, deadline driven and self-starters
- You must live in Fredericton or within commuting distance from the city in order to access NBFC workshops and equipment. Travel subsidy and cost of living are NOT covered by this mentorship.

Your Application Must Include:

- ½ to 1 page film treatment
 - Production schedule that demonstrates the project will be completed on time
 - Budget that demonstrates the project can be completed within the scope of this mentorship

- ½ to 1 page statement on why you'd like to participate and how you would benefit from participation
- Your bio (no CVs or resumes, please). Please be sure to indicate past experience with film and other artistic mediums, if any, and your Indigenous affiliation
